One of the first steps to getting your kitchen design is supplying measurements. Accurate measurements are important as even the smallest discrepancies can cause a big headache. Luckily we've got you covered with this handy measuring guide.

Step 1: Locate a tape measurer, pencil, and a sheet of paper.

Step 2: Sketch out a basic drawing of your kitchen.

Step 3: Measure. Now you will assign dimensions to your sketch. Start in one corner and simply work your way around the room. Be sure to note all doors and windows (include the trim in window or door measurement)

Step 4: Please place and provide measurements of your appliances. This will be easy if you're keeping your appliances. Just let us know how big they are and where they are. If you're replacing your appliances please email your designer with the model numbers and we can figure out their dimensions.

Step 5: Let us know where your sink center is. This way we can make sure that your plumbing will line up with where we place your sink.

Step 6: Measure your ceiling height and note any existing soffits if they're staying.
